The much delayed third instalment of the Northcott Leeward Islands and Mauritius collection is duly presented.

This auction predominantly contains King George VI errors and printing varieties including probably the largest offering ever of the newly SG listed serrated edge flaw (RP10/5) on KGVI stamps of Leeward Islands and Mauritius. There are also many other varieties listed for both countries including Leeward Islands King Edward VII 1902 3d block of 4 SG24 with one showing SG unlisted on this value damaged frame & crown (Spaven) flaw plus a third copy of SG unlisted KGVI 10/- Williams Lea & Co printing with “Break in top frame” flaw only on this printing.

A peculiarity of the 8/4RP flaw found only on the 11/42 ½d and 3d is a partly solid rosette within the triangle.

Flaws on any one printing occur on all values of that printing.

As a general rule if the flaws are not on printings as listed this is because of heavy inking or the nature of the impression. Sometimes it is the result of hand retouching (hand painting).

Requisition 7025/1 is divided into three states A, B and C.

A is the initial printing. However damage to the key plate prior to the printing of the key plate sheets for the 20c and 2R50 values meant those two values showed serious flaws at LP6/1, 8/3, 8/4 and 9/3 (the broken frame flaw). These two values are listed as 7025/1B.

LP9/3 was repaired resulting in the 'strengthened rosette' flaw. Using the key plate in this state a reprint was made of all values except the 10c 12c and 20c. The reprint is listed as 7025/1C. The reprint did not replace the initial printing and the whole requisition was issued.

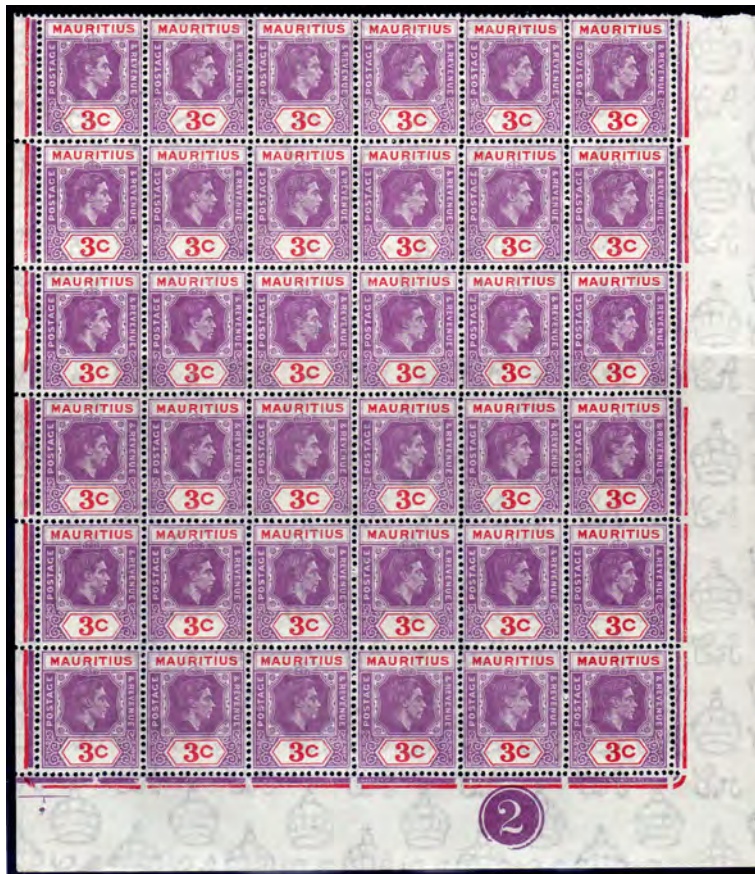
